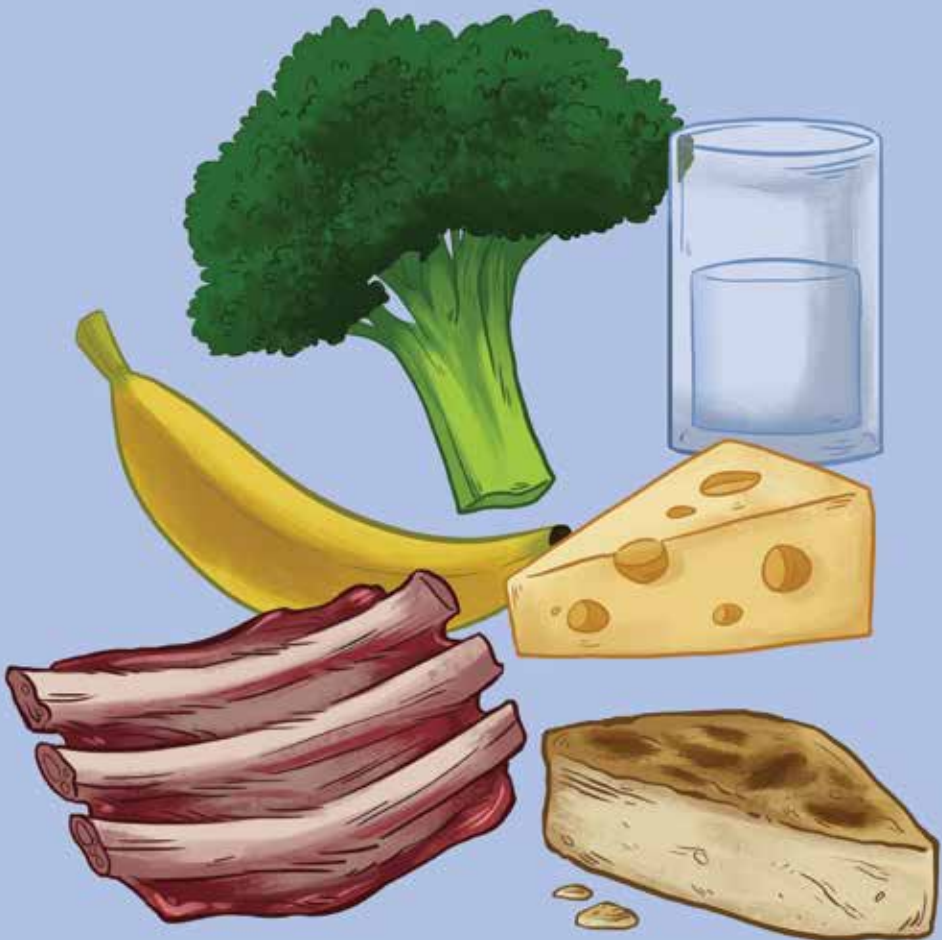


Niqinnariktunik Nirijumajuktunga
